## INSTALLING MULTIRIP SOFTWARE

Below are instructions for how to install the MultiRIP multiple application RIP software.

**NOTE:** You need to install the Epson print driver that comes with your printer before you install the MultiRIP Software. Otherwise, you will have to manual set the ports for the PowerRIP Output Queue #1 and MultiRIP Stylus Pro X800 print drivers. Click on the link below for the post that explains this process -

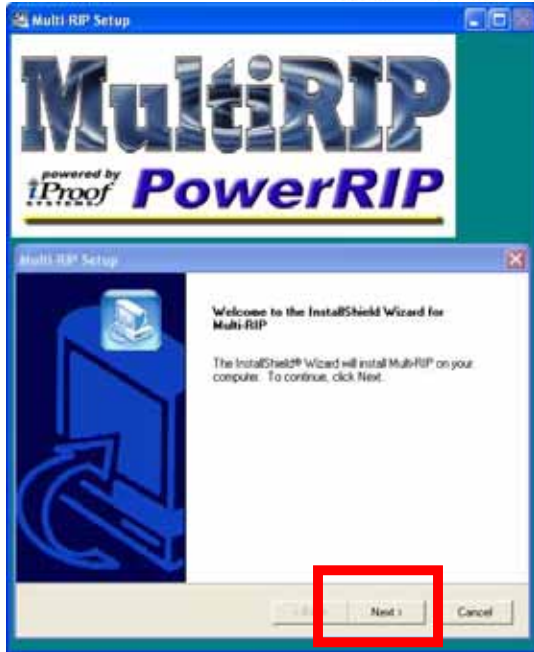

1. Either put the MultiRIP CD into your CD drive or download the software from the website at [www.iproofsystems.com/multirip/MultiRIP\\_CD.exe](http://www.iproofsystems.com/multirip/MultiRIP_CD.exe).
2. The following screen will show up and you will want to click on the link for Install MultiRIP.

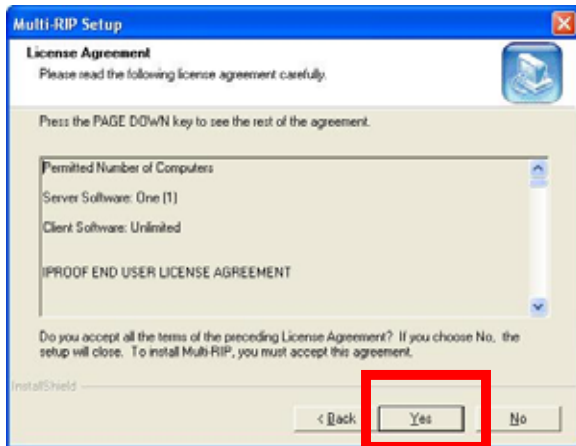


3. The following screen will show up and you will need to click on the Next button to launch the InstallWizard for MultiRIP.


4. You will need to agree to the License Agreement in order to install MultiRIP on your computer. We recommend that you read this agreement. To accept the terms of this Agreement, click on the Yes button.




5. The next screen is the Registration Information screen. Please type in your name, company name and Serial / Product Code number. The Product Code number can be found on the inside cover of the CD Case and also in the Introductory Email that was sent from [support@multirip.com](mailto:support@multirip.com). If you are unable to locate the Product Code, please email [support@multirip.com](mailto:support@multirip.com) and continue the registration process by entering EVALUATION in this field.

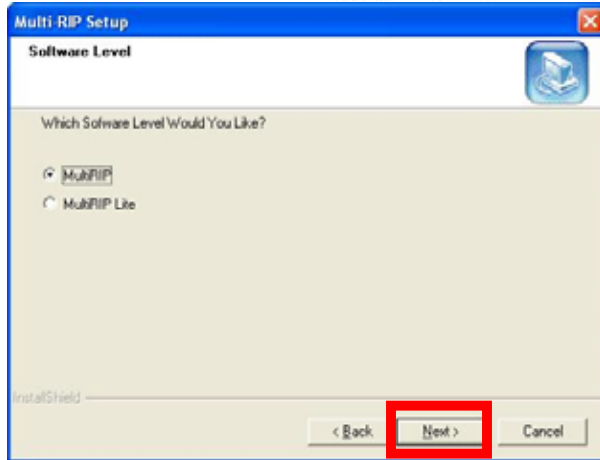


6. The next screen will ask you to choose which printer model version of MultiRIP you have purchased from our distributor. Once you have chosen the correct printer model, please click on the Next button. Below are your choices of available printer models:
- Epson R1800 Printer (coming soon)
  - Epson 4800 Printer
  - Epson 7800 Printer

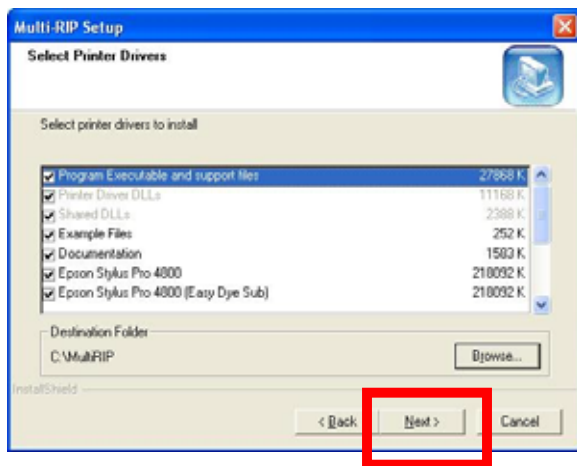


7. The next screen will ask you to choose which Software Level you have purchased. Once you have chosen the correct level, please click on the Next button. Below are the different versions of Software Levels.
- MultiRIP – screen printing film positives, dye sublimation & inkjet transfers, photographs and general printing items
  - MultiRIP Lite - dye sublimation & inkjet transfers, photographs and general printing items

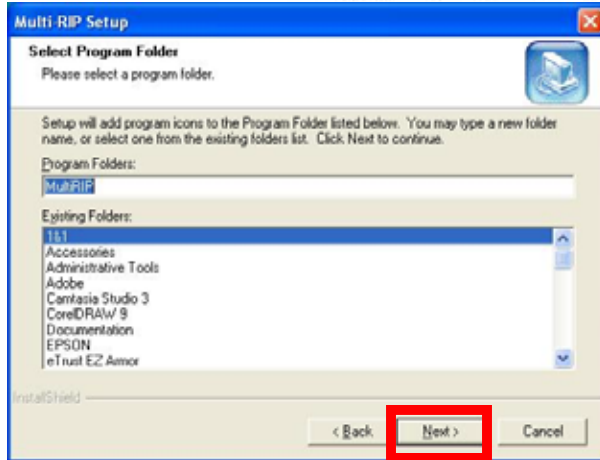


8. The next screen will ask you to select the Print Drivers that will be installed on your computer. All of the appropriate Print Drivers will be selected based on your previous responses. Just click the Next button.

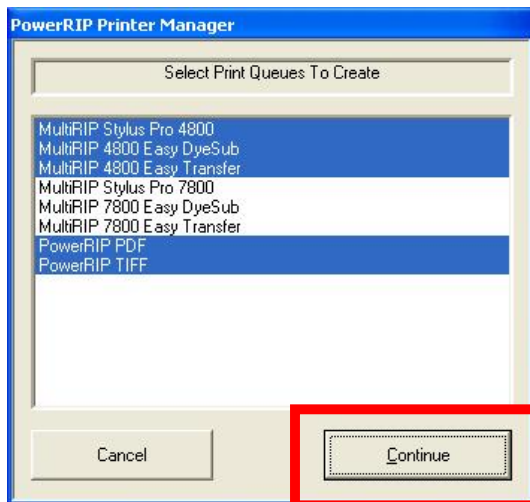


9. The next screen is going to ask you which Program Folder you will want MultiRIP's software to be installed into. For technical support reasons, we recommend to keep the name the same and just click the Next button.

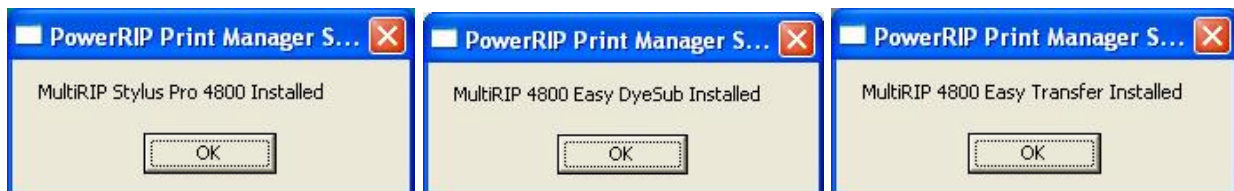

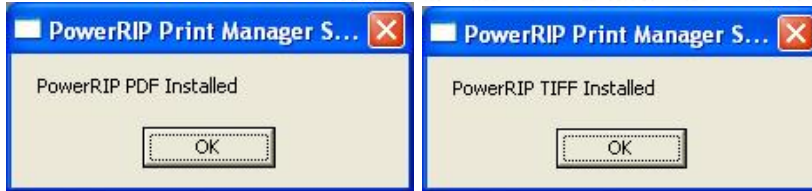
10. The next screen is going to ask you which Print Queues should be installed into the Printer & Faxes Folder on your computer. Based on your previous selections, all the correct queues will be already highlighted. Please click the Continue button.



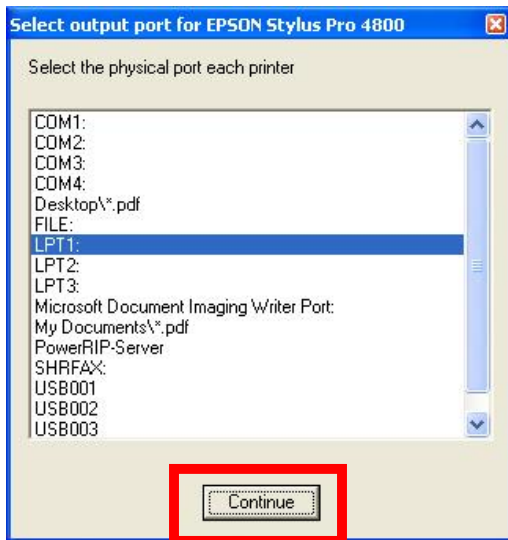
11. The InstallWizard will begin to install all the proper software and print queues. You will notice that a series of windows like the ones listed below will pop-up. Please click the OK buttons.



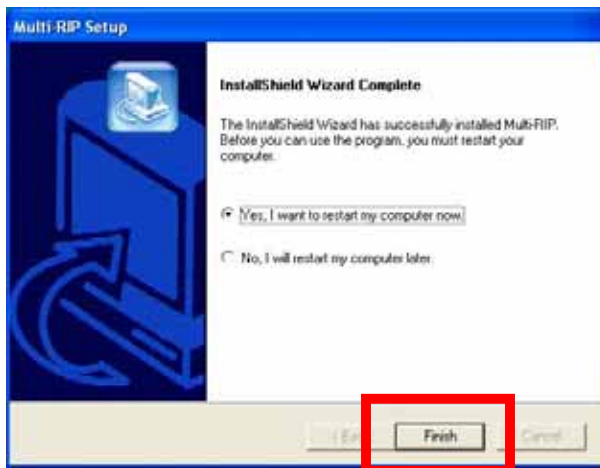

12. The next screen will ask you to select the correct Printer Port to run MultiRIP through. If you have already installed the Epson 4800 Printer Driver on your computer, the correct port will already be highlighted and you will need to click the Continue button. If the 4800 Printer Driver is not already installed, you will need to check the Online Support Forum ([www.multiripusers.com](http://www.multiripusers.com)) to see how to set the correct ports for the different printer drivers.



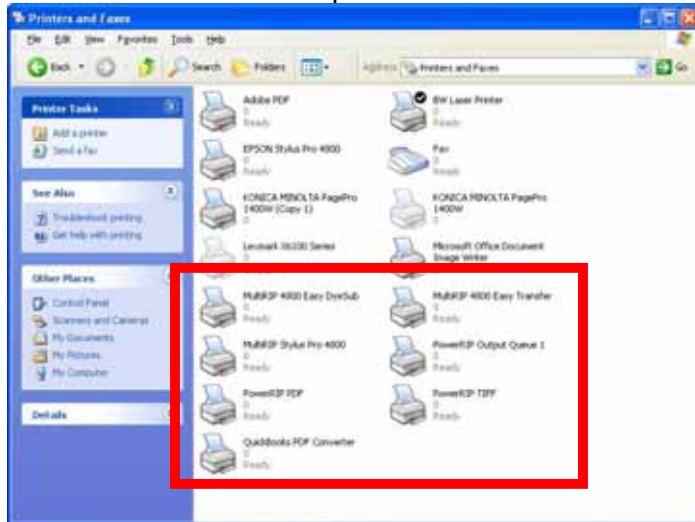
13. The next screen will ask you whether you want to restart your computer now or later. You will need to restart your computer before you can use the MultiRIP software



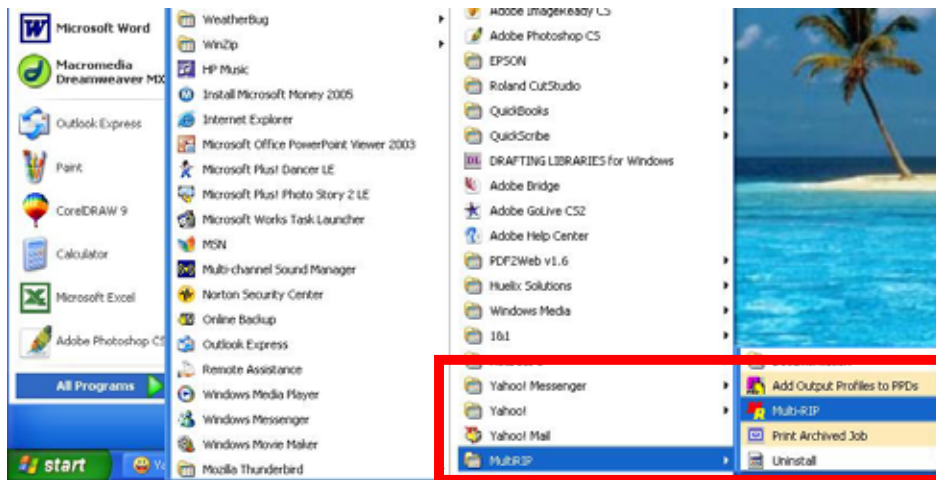

14. After your computer restarts, click on the Start button and go to your Control Panel. Once the new screen open up, you will want to go into the Printers and Faxes folder. You should see that several new print drivers in this window.

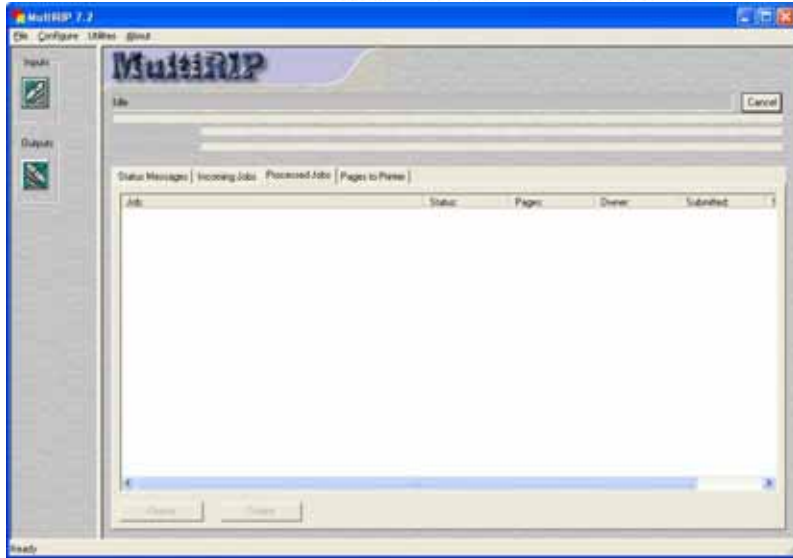


15. The final step is to click on the Start button and put your cursor over the All Programs link and find the MultiRIP program to click on the MultiRIP software.



The RIP interface window will open up.

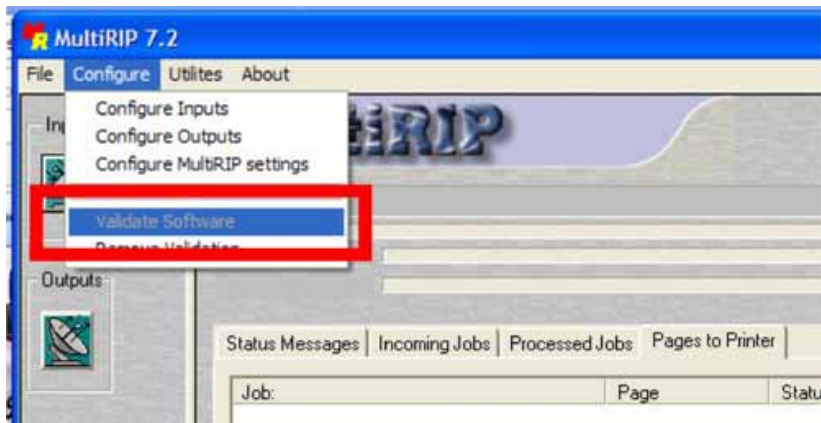
# MultiRIP

MultiRIP's copy protection is a security-key based system which is validated by the user by obtaining an "unlock code" or "activation code" from the iProof web server using the supplied "product code". The validation is installed on the server externally of the MultiRIP software. This means that, once validated, you can un-install and re-install MultiRIP as many times as you want on the same server without having to re-validate. If you wish to move MultiRIP to a different server system, you can remove the validation, log on to the iProof validation server to perform the validation removal procedure, then re-install MultiRIP on a different server and validate again.

## CHAPTER 1: VALIDATING MULTIRIP SOFTWARE (📺 [Video Available](#))

To validate MultiRIP and get rid of the pesky "MultiRIP" watermark, you must purchase the software. Once you have purchased it you will receive a "product code" which you will use to obtain a validation code from our server.

1. Open "Validate MultiRIP" from the "Configure" menu option.



This will open the MultiRIP Server validation dialog



2. Write down the user code (you'll need it for the next step) and leave this window open.
3. Next, log on to [www.iproofsystems.com/validation](http://www.iproofsystems.com/validation) using your favorite web browser. Select the language you want the Registration screen to be displayed in.

4. Complete the entire Registration Form and double check it for accuracy. Enter your product code (the 16-character code either on the CD or the CD case) in the box marked "Please enter your product code"



NOTE: The email address you include on this form will be the email address that your log-in information for MultiRIP's User Forum will be sent to.

5. Then click on the "Validate" link in the box for MultiRIP.

6. The validation page will appear and you will need to enter your Product Code (16 digits code that came with your software) and you User Code (6 – 9 digit code that shows up in Step #2.).

To validate MultiRIP, please follow these 3 steps.

1. From the PowerRIP program click on **Configure** then click on **Validate Software**. At this point, you will be presented with a User Code and prompted for an Activation Code. To get the Activation Code do step 2.
2. Enter your **Product Code** enclosed in your software and **User Code** from the MultiRIP program into the fields below, You will be presented with an **Activation Code**.
3. This Activation Code should then be entered into the Activation Code field of the MultiRIP program.

**ALL codes are CASE sensitive**

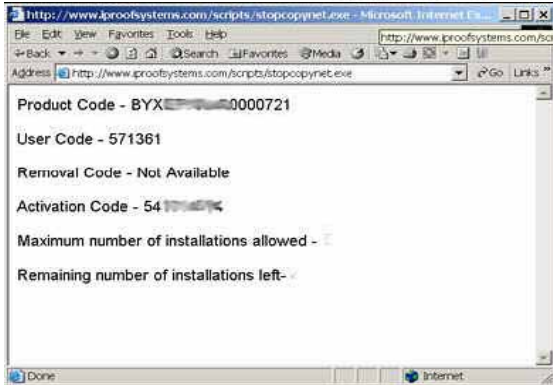

7. If the numbers were entered correctly, the next page will supply you with a validation code. You will need to go back to the MultiRIP Interface and enter the Activation Code in the appropriate field.

8. Click Submit.

9. Enter the validation code (activation code) into MultiRIP's validation dialog:



10. Click OK. A dialog will appear informing you that MultiRIP is now validated.

11. Close MultiRIP. The validation will not take effect until MultiRIP is re-launched.
