RIP crashes when printing multiple film positives from Illustrator.

Problem: When printing from Illustrator, you are able to print a single color film positive perfectly fine. However, you are not able to print a multi-color film positive because it crashes the RIP early on in the processing part of the RIP.

Potential Answer: The problem comes about because of a setting in Illustrator is crashing the engine (i.e. Jaws Interpreter) of the RIP. When you are in the print window of Illustrator (File --> Print), you need to select Output on the left side. Then in the Mode drop-down box, you need to have Separations - (Host Based) selected. Below is a picture illustrating this.
