Why are the files not printing when using the Imposition feature?

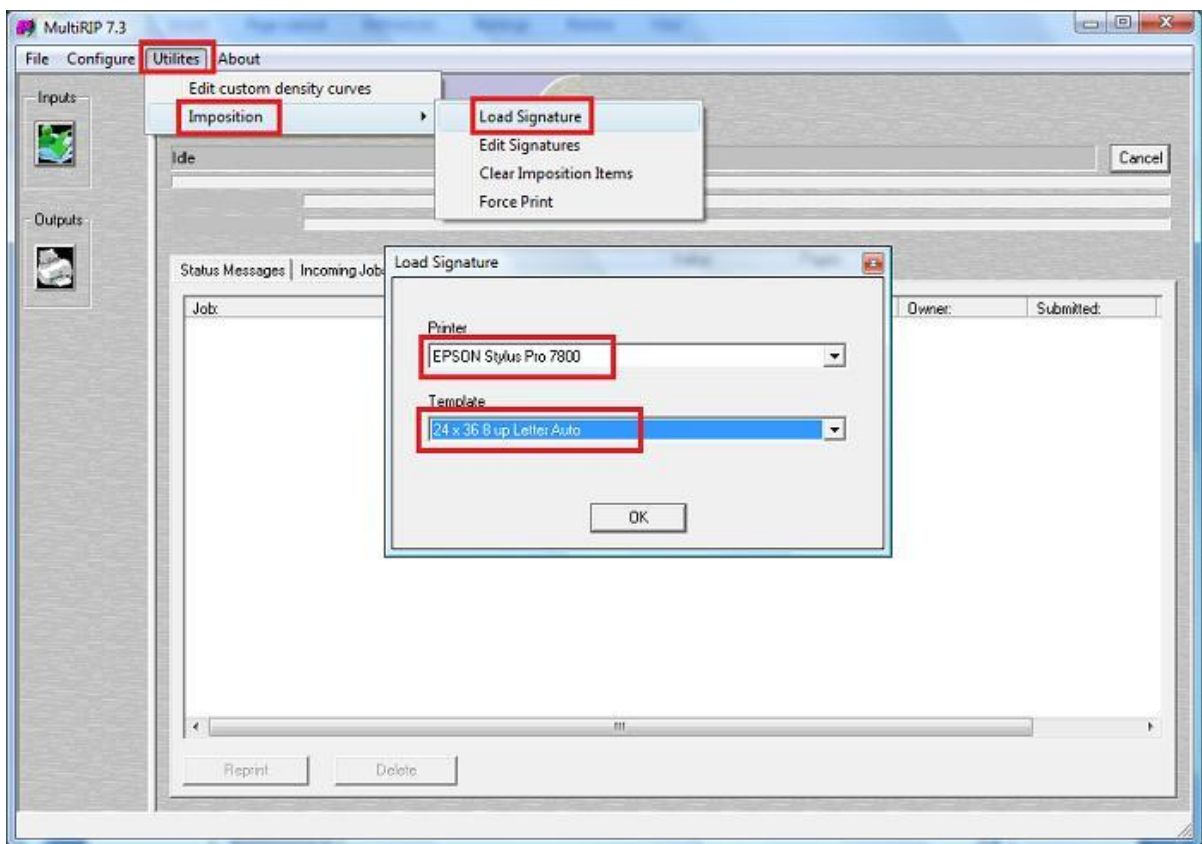
Problem: After you setup your Signature Page in the Imposition Feature of MultiRIP, the files are processed through the RIP and they stay in the Processed Jobs tab with a status message of Waiting.

Potential Answer: The way the Imposition feature works is that it will tell the RIP to process a page and place it on hold (i.e. Waiting) until you have completely filled the entire Signature file you setup in the RIP. Then it will take the individual files and "Assemble" them into one file that is sent to the printer. For more details on how this works, please watch these two videos:

If the Assembling portion is not happening, it is probably because the Signature is not full or you did not load the signature into the RIP. Here is a picture illustrating how to load the Signature Page.



If the files are not printing after loading the Signature file, you have two options.

1. You can Force Print and it will have the RIP sent whatever is in the Signature to the RIP. Please note, that if your Signature file is 25" tall (2 high and 3 wide) and you only have 3 files in there, it is going to spit out the entire amount of media that is set up in your signature file.
2. You can clear all the files in the Imposition feature and start over. To do this, you will select the Clear Imposition Items feature in the RIP.
