How to Upgrade MultiRIP for the Latest Features

MultiRIP can be either installed on your computer via a CD that is mailed to you or can be downloaded from iProof Systems' server. From time to time, we will add new features, correct software bugs and add new profiles to the software. All customers have the ability to upgrade their software by downloading the software from the link below.

Due to the size of the program, you will need high speed internet access to download the software. If you don't have access to high speed internet, then you can request for another CD to be mailed to you for a nominal fee.

NOTE: Before you can install the new version of MultiRIP, you need to uninstall of the software. For these instructions, click on the link below:

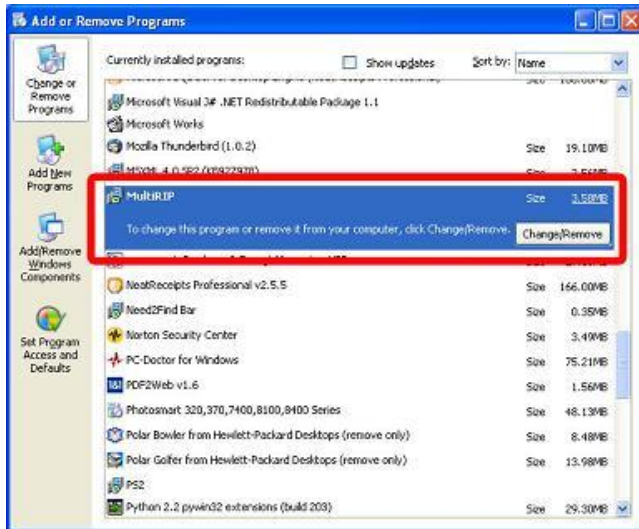
How to Uninstall Existing Version of MultiRIP to Upgrade (Keep the Same Validation)

Below are the instructions for doing an Uninstall of MultiRIP, but keep the same Validation.

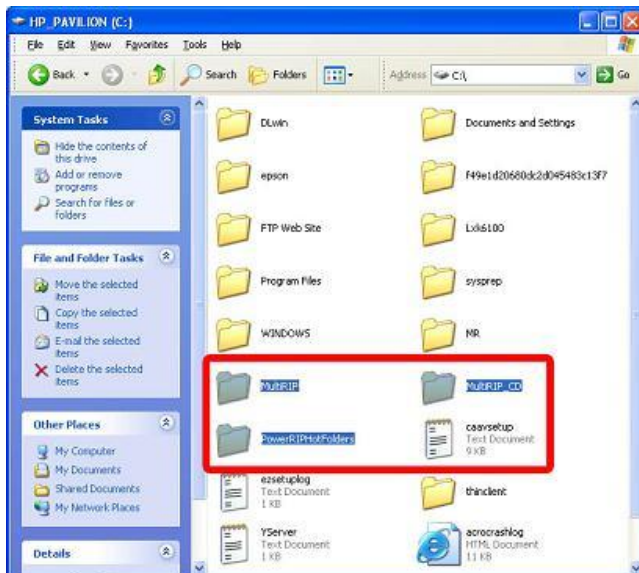
1. Close ALL applications. This is very important to make sure that the following steps occur correctly.
2. Un-install MultiRIP by going to your Start button à to the Control Panel and click on the Add/Remove Software icon.



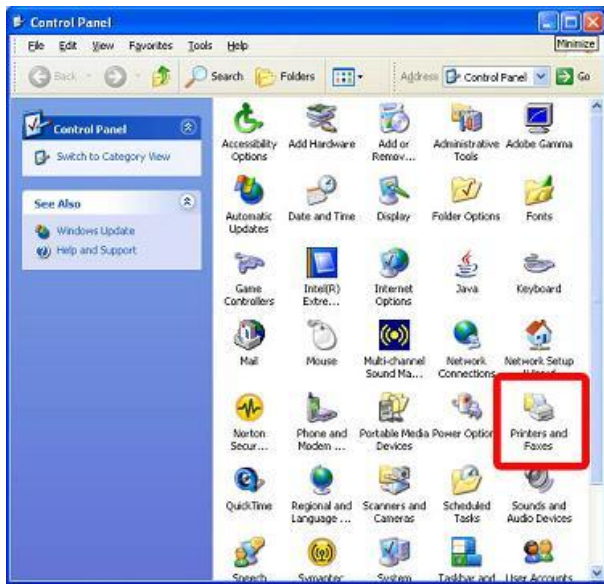
3. Scroll through the list and click on MultiRIP. The area will become highlighted and click on the Change/Remove button.



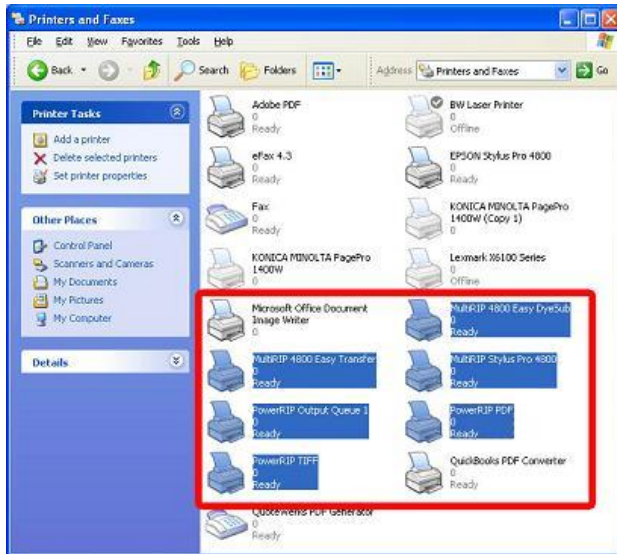
4. Once this process is completed, minimize (don't close) the Control Panel window. Go to the Start Button and open the C:/ Drive window. You will need to delete any folders that contain MultiRIP or PowerRIP like the following: MultiRIP, MultiRIP_CD, PowerRIPLayouts and PowerRIPHotFolders. You can delete these folders by holding the Control key down and left click on each folders and then click on the Delete button.



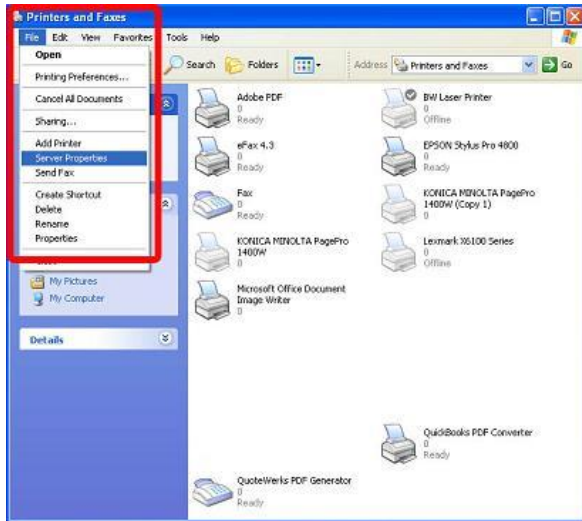
5. Go back into the Control Panel (the window that is minimized) and click on the icon for Printers & Faxes.



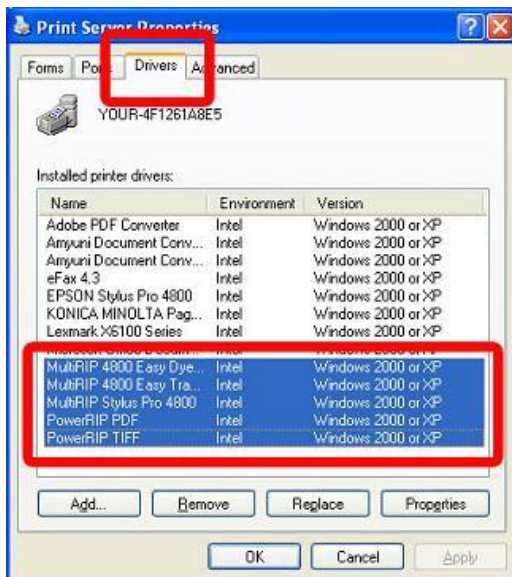
6. You will now need to delete the following Printers: MutliRIP x800 Easy Dye Sub, MultiRIP x800 Easy Transfer, MultiRIP Stylus Pro x800, PowerRIP Output Queue 1, PowerRIP PDF and PowerRIP TIFF.



7. Once the MultiRIP Printers are deleted, you will need to go to the File Menu (located at the top left side of the screen) and click on Server Properties.



8. In the Server Properties window, click on the Drivers tab and delete the following drivers: MultiRIP x800 Easy Dye Sub, MultiRIP x800 Easy Transfer, MultiRIP Stylus Pro x800, PowerRIP PDF and PowerRIP TIFF.



9. Once this is completed, closed all the windows and restart your computer. Then, click on the link below and save the file you your desktop before you install the latest version of MultiRIP.
